The program uses a **Plain English** dictionary to help writers **simplify** citizen information, web pages, forms and important state or federal government instructions.

In 2011, New York State issued Executive Order No 26.

"Approximately two and a half million New Yorkers do not speak English as their primary language and have limited ability to read, speak, write, or understand English. This presents potential barriers when trying to access important government benefits or services."



The New York State Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), Albany HQ, awarded the SMART team a contract to help the agency simplify forms and DMV information.

The SMART team uses the SMART **Text Miner** to develop custom Plain English dictionaries. The SMART linguists remove *legalese* to make citizen services easier to understand.



The writers are guided by AI rules in the **MAXit Checker**. These rules show corrections in grammar, vocabulary, syntax and style. US Federal Government agencies must comply with the federal **Plain Writing Act of 2010** and other digital and language mandates.

The AI rules in the **MAXit Checker** help convert *legalese* to Plain English for digitalization, modernization, simplification and data transformation.

The results are materials in clear, concise, Plain English that are easy to read, understand and translate.

HOW TO ENROLL IN THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF
①HEALTH'S DONATE LIFE REGISTRY

If you are 18 years or older, you ②may enroll in the Registry through either DMV or DOH.

You can enroll through DMV with an MV-44 application form.

③Simply read the Organ Donation statement and sign and ④date the Donor Consent Signature line. You can ⑤also enroll at renewal time by ⑥signing the Donor Consent line on your MV-2 renewal form. ⑦As of July 22, 2008, your signature on an MV-44 or MV-2 ⑧constitutes legal consent for donation. ⑨Be sure to tell your family that you have legally ⑩consented to be a donor ⑪upon your death. If you enroll through DMV, the words "ORGAN DONOR" will ⑫automatically be printed on the front of your ⑬DMV-issued photo document.

Explanation of key points for Writers.

- ① Other languages do not use the possessive form. .
- ② Do not use auxiliary verbs like may, might, could, should, shall.
- ③ This adverb does not add any value.
- ④ Some nouns are not used as verbs. Use only approved verbs.
- ⑤ This adverb is not necessary.
- ⑥ Avoid the gerunds (-ing words). They do not show who does the action.
- ⑦ Use PE date style, avoid obsolete dates, or use international formats.
- ⑧ Avoid legalese which most citizens do not understand.
- ⑨ Change *be sure* to the stronger verb **make sure**.
- ⑩ Rephrase to change verb **consent** to the noun (give consent).
- ⑪ Rephrase reference to **death**. Use **after your death**.
- ⑫ This adverb is not necessary.
- ⑬ Avoid fused adjectives which do not translate.

You must be 18 or older to enroll in the **Donate Life Registry** at either the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) or the Department of Health (DOH).

Use the DMV form **MV-44** to enroll in the **Donate Life Registry**. Read the organ donation information, then add the date and write your name on the line marked **Donor Consent**.

You can enroll during the renewal of your driver license. Use the DMV form **MV-2** to write your name on the line marked **Donor Consent**. Your signature on these forms gives your legal consent for an organ donation after your death. Make sure to tell your family that you gave consent for an organ donation.

IMPORTANT: The words "ORGAN DONOR" are shown on the front of your driver license.
